During the course of the evening a synchronized program of 25 vernissages for diverse art exhibitons will be held in various venues. The evening will be enriched through programs of music, fashion and performance. A very special attraction to this line-up is the dance and projection installation being co-ordinated by the German photographer and artist, Gabriela Rosa da Silva. Mimosa Sunday International

Berlin / Paris

Beginning on May 21, 2006 the cities of Berlin and Paris will have one more thing in common: Mimosa Sunday. A monthly program which originated in Berlin-Friedrichshain in 2001 under the name *Mimosa Sonntag*, will now be simultaneously orchestrated in the art districts of Friedrichshain and Montmartre under the new international name *Mimosa Sunday*. As customary in Berlin, the event will take place on the third Sunday of each month offering visitors the opportunity to visit the actual gallery exhibitions, artist studios and program offerings at partner locations. A complementary Mimosa cocktail, with its origin in the Paris Ritz Hotel, will be served to visitors in both cities.
